Progress on Route 39 Academy

Since the last issue the project has moved on significantly. All of the foundations are complete together with the ground floor concrete slab, and the reinforced concrete frame between ground and first floors is progressing at pace.

May



Excavation and concreting of the foundations continues.



Preparation and pouring of the ground floor concrete slab commences.



Concrete pours to the ground floor slab continue throughout the month.

June



Our concrete frame contractor commences.



Reinforcement to the ground to first floor concrete columns and walls is installed.



Concrete to the columns and walls is poured and falsework / formwork to the first floor slab is erected.



Steel reinforcement to the first floor slab is then fixed and concrete poured.



The first of five concrete pours to the first floor slab is complete.



Four GRP tanks that make up the foul treatment plant are lifted into position.

Works Planned in the next Period

- The reinforced concrete columns and walls between ground and first floors will be completed.
- Concrete pouring to the first floor reinforced concrete slab will continue.
- Storm and foul drainage from the building will continue.


'All Safe' June 2017

June saw the return of our annual 'All Safe' campaign. During the month we held a number of events aimed at engaging everyone on site in a discussion about health and safety and mental health.

The most powerful presentation of the month was given by Dylan Skelhorn (featured in the poster opposite), who suffered life changing injuries as a result of a fall from height whilst working within the construction industry.

Dylan gave us a candid talk on what happened in the weeks leading up to his accident, how events unfolded on the day of his accident, and how he and his family have struggled to come to terms with his injuries over the last 7 years.

Hearing Dylan's story first hand certainly put everyone on site in a reflective mood, and brought to the forefront why health and safety is our number one priority.
